

Sermon Notes

A Life Well Lived

Using the “3C” biographical study method.

1. Collect information about the person you are studying: Acts chapters 16 through 20, Romans 16:21, 1st Corinthians 4:17; 16:10, 2nd Corinthians 1:1,19, Philippians 1:1; 2:19-23, Colossians 1:1, 1st Thessalonians 1:1; 3:2,6, 2nd Thessalonians 1:1, Philemon 1, Hebrews 13:23, and, of course, both letters Paul wrote to him.
2. Correlate the information into an outline: a historical sketch.
 - a. His early life in Lystra.
 - b. His call and gifting for ministry.
 - c. His development by observation and experience.
 - d. His effective ministry with team members and on his own.
 - e. His imprisonment, release, and final ministry.

You could also use the information identified last week as an outline giving a character portrait.

- a. grounded
- b. growing
- c. genuine
- d. gracious
- e. godly

Authenticity is the basis for authority, and faithfulness is the basis for fruitfulness.

The title for this outline could be: A life well lived.

3. Crystallize what you’ve learned into some applications.
